A subscription encouraging 8-12-year-olds from all backgrounds to pursue STEM by teaching them the life skill of repair.

Every month, we send children electronic gadgets with carefully planned faults and all the tools needed to fix them. Guided by our app, children not only learn how to **fix everyday objects** - allowing them to live more sustainably - but **learn the STEM concepts** behind the components they are fixing, like microprocessors and motors.



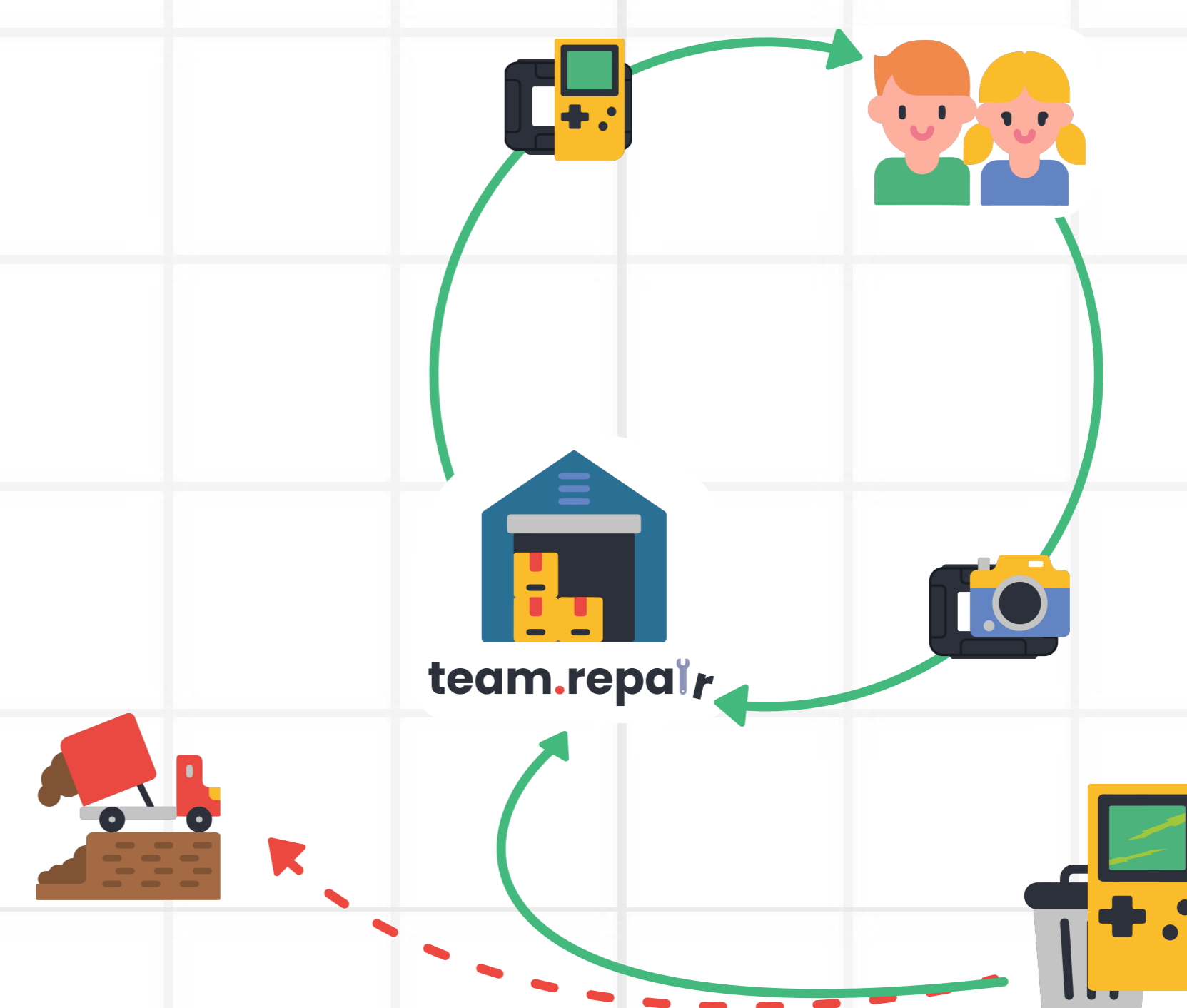
We are on a mission to solve some of society's biggest problems

1. The **lack of diversity in STEM**, where women make up only 27% of STEM professionals - contributing to the STEM skill shortage costing the UK over £1.5 billion a year.
2. The **e-waste crisis**, where in London alone, over 500,000kg of electronic waste is sent to landfill every single day.

We have a truly circular business model.



Our subscription is powered by our **innovative circular business model**. Our gadgets are sourced from manufacturer product returns, redirecting them from landfill and shipped in reusable plastic boxes. At the end of each month, the box and gadget are returned, so that we can **reuse them** again the next month.



Our R&D workshops programme

To extend our impact, we have partnered with the Restart Project and the East London Waste Authority to run **free workshops in London's disadvantaged communities**. We use these workshops to trial new Team Repair boxes and have now tested our product with over 100 users.
